Part of MAWF development of fresh produce infrastructure throughout Namibia, which includes a market building equipped with cold rooms, ripening rooms, wash & grading areas, lab, dock levellers, etc. for fresh produce storing and trading; an administrative building, bulk civil services (roads, pump station, etc.) and serviced plots along inside perimeter of the hub. The hub covers an area of approximately 15ha.

- Bulk services: water connection, sewerage connection, road access road, storm- water outfall;
- · Earthworks, internal roads and storm-water designs;
- Electrical reticulation designs;
- Back-up power generation systems;
- · Communication network designs
 - Internal water and sewerage reticulation;
 - Sewerage pump- and lifting stations
 - Water booster pump stations
 - · Rational fire design for entire site
 - Firewater pump station, wet sprinkler system, fire water network & hydrant reticulation.
