



The construction of the new Otjiwarongo Hospital will improve referral and service delivery. It will reduce the number of referral of patients to Windhoek and Katutura hospitals in Windhoek and in doing so improve access to appropriate healthcare. When completed, the hospital will encompass the following facilities:

- 1. Otjiwarongo class B2 hospital (250 beds)
- 2. Regional clinical engineering workshop
- 3. Mother and pre-birth lodge
- 4. Ophthalmology ward
- 5. Emergency medical services
- 6. Orthotic and prosthetic regional workshop
- 7. Conference centre for regional and facility organizational development
  - 8. Staff accommodation
  - 9. Student accommodation
  - 10. Heliport

The scope of the project is as follows:
Site clearance, fencing, bulk services
(earthworks, access road, water & sewer),
housing (staff accommodation),
conference centre, service building
(laundry, mortuary, kitchen, etc.),
administration building, main hospital
building, site infrastructure (roads, water,
sewer, electric services, water tanks,
water treatment plant, gate houses,
emergency medical services (EMS)
