



The retail fuel station consists of multiple components necessary for accommodating the provision of unimpeded fuel supply and retail services to passing traffic around the project area. The Project includes:

- a fuel station building with trading area (200m²), kitchen and takeaway area, dry and cold stores, plant area, public and staff ablutions, managers office, ATM facilities and pump attendant's rest room
- mechanical installations such as air conditioning and refrigeration for the shop;
- installation of island pumps (fuel dispensing systems) and tanks (fuel storage tank farm with 180m³ capacity) with a COC,
 - canopies for retail and commercial dispensing areas
 - electrical installations;
 - construction of site storm water systems as well as water and sewer reticulation network, including the construction of a pump station;
 - construction of an intersection with access road and access slip line as well as interlocked paving
 - paving of the truckport parking area
 - environmental spill containment and treatment system
 - security monitoring
